All employees and contractors are expected to co-operate with Samka Architectural Solutions Limited in the implementation of this Policy and will ensure that their own work, so far as is reasonably practicable, is carried out with minimum risk to the environment. Consultation with all relevant stakeholders will be structured to ensure environmental awareness and to encourage feedback so as to continually improve our environmental management systems.
